Labs: Migrating Cisco DCNM to NDFC Lab

During this lab, we will demonstrate how to migrate from Cisco Data Center Network Manager (DCNM) to the next-generation Cisco Nexus Dashboard Fabric Controller (NDFC). The process involved is backing up DCNM and then in place restore to NDFC. This simple lab gives the user a look into the process.

This lab has the following sections.

Preparing the server for backup

- Obtaining the pre-backup file from Cisco
- · SCP the pre-backup file to DCNM
- · Executing the pre-backup file
- SCP the zipped DCNM backup file to the desktop
- Upgrading to Nexus Dashboard Fabric Controller

Logging into Nexus Dashboard

- Enabling the Nexus Dashboard Fabric Controller Application
- Launching the Fabric Controller
- · Restoring the saved DCNM information into NDFC
